

Autex Interior Acoustics and Quietspace® products are extremely durable and require little attention to maintain their good looks. Light vacuuming on a regular basis will prevent dust build up and most marks can be cleaned with a mild detergent solution followed by rinsing and blotting. Stains should be dealt with according to the chart below.

Before carrying out a proposed cleaning method, apply to a concealed section to ensure it will not affect the adhesive or product. Avoid severe abrasion. Spot clean only. Vacuum to restore pile, but do not use a stiff brush.

NB: We do not recommend using solvent-based solutions on Autex Interior Acoustics and Quietspace® products.
